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# **1. INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 In order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority and to empower the citizens to secure access to information under the control of each public authority, the Government of India have enacted “The Right to Information Act, 2005”, (RTI Act) which came into force on 15.06.2005. In accordance with the provisions of section 4(1) (b) of this Act, Bengaluru Central University has brought out this Manual for information and guidance of the general public.
- 1.2 The purpose of this Manual is to inform the general public about the organizational set-up of Bengaluru Central University, the functions and duties of its officers and employees and records and documents available with the University.
- 1.3 This manual is aimed at the public in general and users of the services and provides information about the Rules, Regulations, Statutes, Schemes, Projects and Programmes being implemented by the University under its administrative control.
- 1.4 The procedure and fee structure for getting information are as under:-

A request for obtaining information under sub-section (1) of section 6 of the RTI Act shall be made in writing, either in person or by post to the Assistant Public Information Officer concerned and must be accompanied by an application fee of Rs.10/- by way of Indian Postal order & DD in favour of the Finance officer Bengaluru Central University, Bengaluru.

- (2) (a) For providing information under sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Right to Information Act, Rs.2/- for each page in respect of matters in A4 size paper. shall be charged.
- <sup>1</sup>[(aa) for providing information disseminated under the sub-section (4) of Section 4 shall be Rupee One per page in respect of matter in A4 size]**
- (b) For providing information under (1) of section 7, in the case Maps, Plans, Reports, a partial record or any technical data or sample or models, a reasonable fee shall be fixed by the Assistant Public Information Officer in each case depending upon the cost of labour and material required to be employed.
- (c) As regards inspection of records and documents, no fee for the first hour. For every subsequent half an hour 2 [or fraction thereof, Rupees ten] shall be charged from persons making application with initial payment as prescribed under Rule 4(1) above. For inspection of works a reasonable fee shall be fixed by the Assistant Public Information Officer in each case depending upon the cost of labour and material required to be employed apart from initial fees as prescribed under Rule 4 (1).

- (3) For providing the information under sub-section (5) of section 7, the fees for supplying information in Diskette or Floppy or C.D. or in any other Electronic Mode shall be Rs. 50/-.
- (4) The fee shall be collected in the form of Indian Postal Order or DD or Bankers Cheque or pay Order drawn in favour of the Finance Officer as per the procedure laid down by the Bengaluru Central University from time to time by way of notifications and circulars.

1.5 Persons below the poverty line are exempted from the payment of fee mentioned in paragraph 1.4 above for seeking information under the Right to Information Act, 2005. The list of persons below poverty line approved by the Gram Panchayat and local bodies will be the basis for claiming this concession. An extract of the list, duly certified by the concerned Tahsildar will be sufficient to avail this concession.

1.6 The Officer mentioned below is appointed as **Nodal Officer** to liaison the work pertaining to Right to Information Act as per Bengaluru Central University RIA Manual.

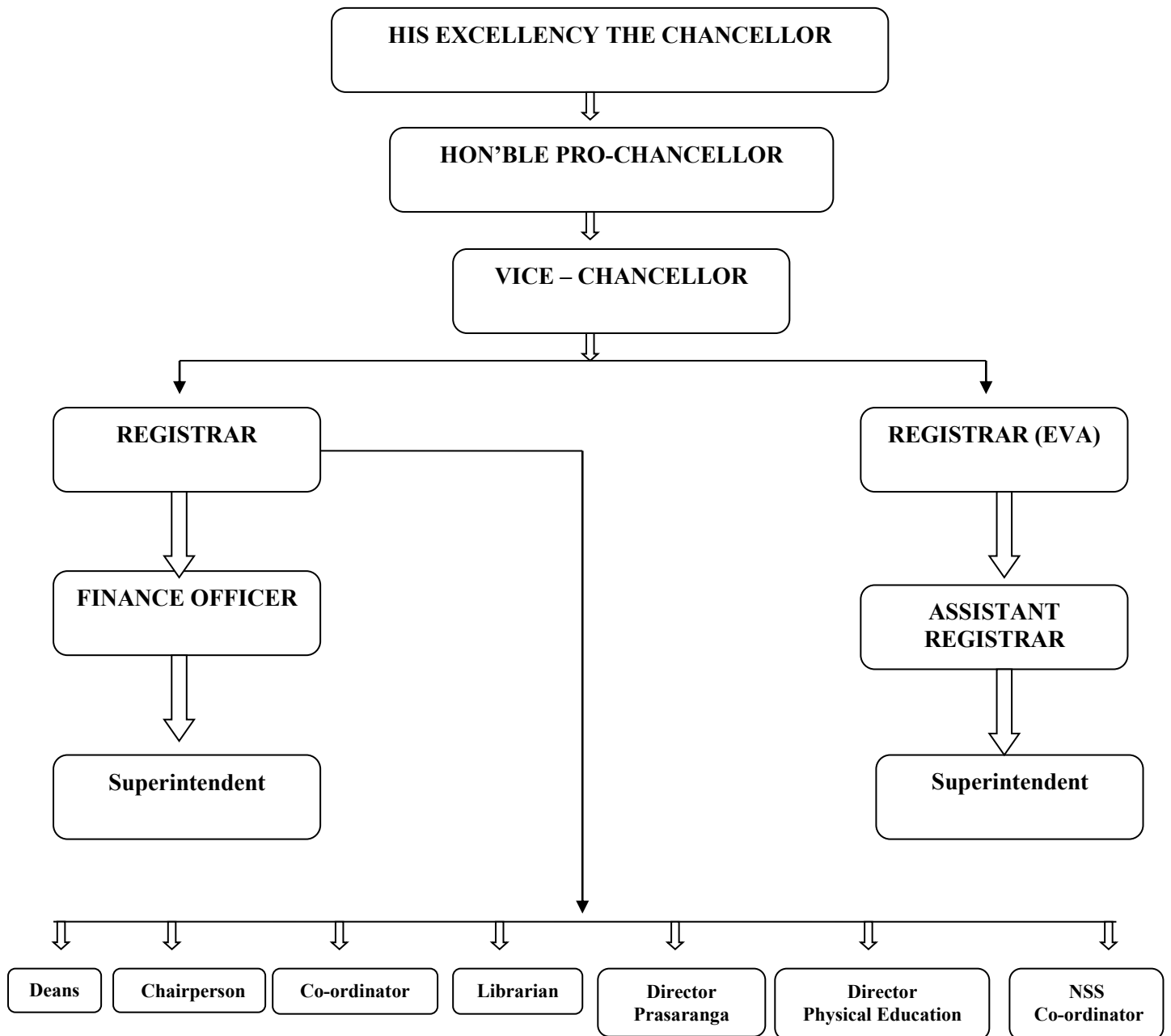

**2. Particulars of organization, functions and duties under (Section 4(1)(b)(i):**

**BENGALURU CENTRAL UNIVERSITY  
ORGANISATIONAL CHART**



**Objectives: -**

- To develop and maintain the educational institutions under the Bengaluru Central University dedicated to organization, conduct and promotion of educational pursuits for under-graduate and post-graduate studies.
- To initiate, sustain and promote research in various faculties of studies in the University
- To undertake endeavours to sub serve the above objects.

**Brief History:**

Bengaluru Central University came into existence after trifurcation from Bangalore University vide Government Gazette Notification dated: 13.08.2015. The Bengaluru Central University as an affiliating University with head quarters at Central College Campus with territorial jurisdiction consisting of Karnataka Legislative Assembly constituencies of Shanthinagara, Byatarayanapura, Yelahanka, Malleshwaram, Hebbal, Shivajinagara, Gandhinagara, Chamarajpet, Chickpet, Basavanagudi, BTM Layout, Jayanagara, and Rajajinagara of Bengaluru District vide gazette notification dated: 13.08.2015. It has 249 affiliated Colleges.

The Bengaluru Central University has 7 P.G. Departments, Mathematics, Chemistry, Biochemistry, Journalism and Mass Communication, Commerce, Management and Centre for Global Languages with courses of M.T.T.M (Master of Tourism and Travel Management), M.Com (International Business), M.Com (Finance & Accounting) and M.B.A (Evening) during 2018-19 Academic Year 8 new PG Departments have been started in the Faculty of Arts i.e. Kannada, English, History, Economics, Sociology, Social Work, Political Science and Philosophy 2019-20 academic year 3 more new PG departments have been started in Physics, Plant Science and Animal Science. Now the Bengaluru Central University has 18 PG Departments.

**Duties of the University:**

- 1 To conduct academic programmes for the preparation of under- graduate and post-graduate examinations in various faculties available in the University, and to undertake activities that are contributory to this object.
- 2 To carryout Research on various frontier issues of Science and issues of science relevance.
- 3 Extension activities.

**Main activities/functions of the University include:-**

- To conduct research in various branches of learning available in the University.
- To facilitate the conduct of add-on courses of duration shorter than the regular ones.
- To undertake various activities so as to supplement the efforts of research and teaching for various degrees and diplomas. This would also include conferring honorary degrees and cooperation with other Universities/other institutions/other bodies.
- To establish specific centers for specialized studies in any branch of learning.
- To take action for institution, maintenance and extension of awards, fellowships, scholarships, prizes etc.
- To maintain colleges and halls of residence.
- To undertake extension activities in the areas relevant to society.

**4. Procedure followed in the decision making process including channels of supervision and accountability under Section 4 (1)(b)(iii):**

The files submitted by the caseworker will be scrutinized by the Superintendent and they will be submitted in turn to the Special Officers / OSD concerned. Later, in the same hierarchy the Special Officers / OSD will submit the files to the Registrar for seeking orders, if required it will also be sent to Vice-Chancellor for approval.

Decisions on Various important matters are taken by the appropriate authorities of the University as per the procedures laid down under various Ordinances, Rules and Regulations of the Bangalore University.

**7. Particulars of any arrangement that exists for consultation with, or representative by the members of the public in relation to the formulation of University policy or implementation thereof under Section 4(1)(b)(vii);**

**Mode of public participation:**

Various Statutory Bodies of the University, namely the University Syndicate and Academic Council comprises of eminent people from society and nominees of the Chancellor of University (Governor of Karnataka) / Government who directly participate in the affairs of the University.

(a) The University Syndicate has:

- two members nominated by the Chancellor from among educationists or persons from commerce, banking industry or other professions;
- six persons nominated by the State Government from amongst eminent educationists of whom
  1. **one** shall be a person belonging to the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes
  2. **one** a person belonging to the other backward classes
  3. **one** a women
  4. **one** a person belonging to religious minorities and
  5. **two** others

(b) The University Academic Council has:

- 1. One member of the Karnataka Legislative Assembly in respect of each district falling within the University area nominated by the Speaker of Karnataka Legislature
- 2. Two members of the Karnataka Legislative Council nominated by the Chairman Karnataka Legislative Council.
- 3. Three eminent persons representing the industry, commerce, banking or any other profession based within the territorial jurisdiction of the University nominated by the State Government for a term not exceeding three years.
- 4. Six persons nominated by the State Government for a term the three years from amongst eminent educationists of whom one belonging to the Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribes; one belonging to the other backward classes; one representing the women; one representing the religious minority and two representing others.

(c) Besides above, various Bodies / Committees constituted by the University has sufficient public representation.

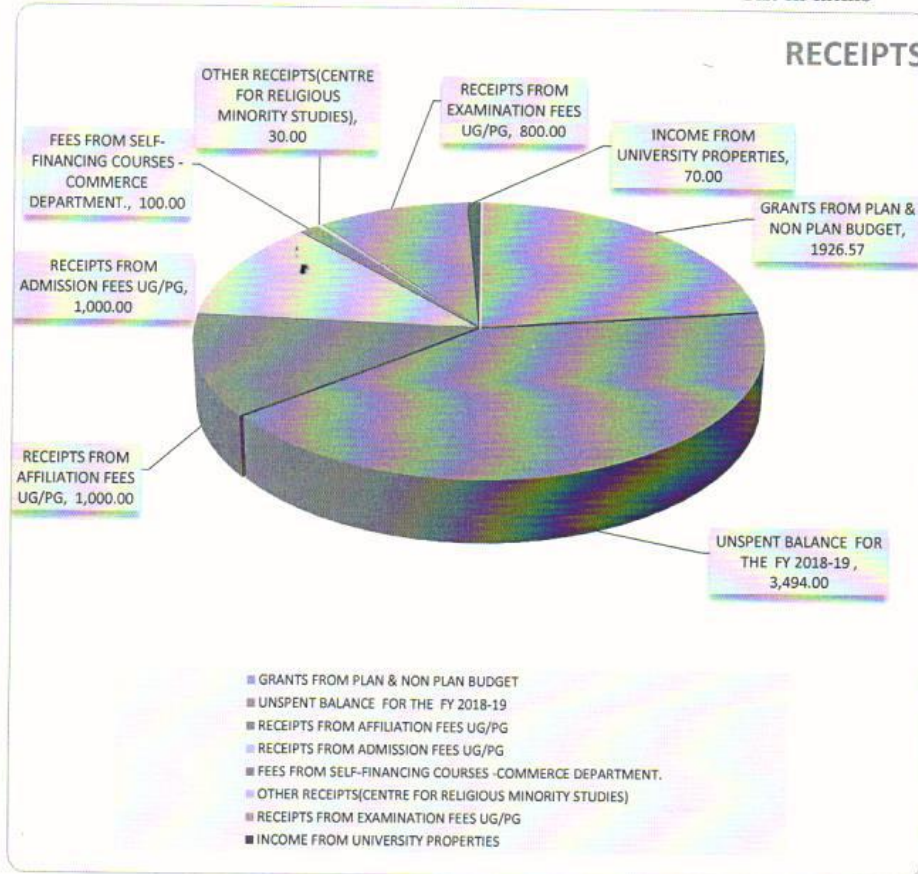

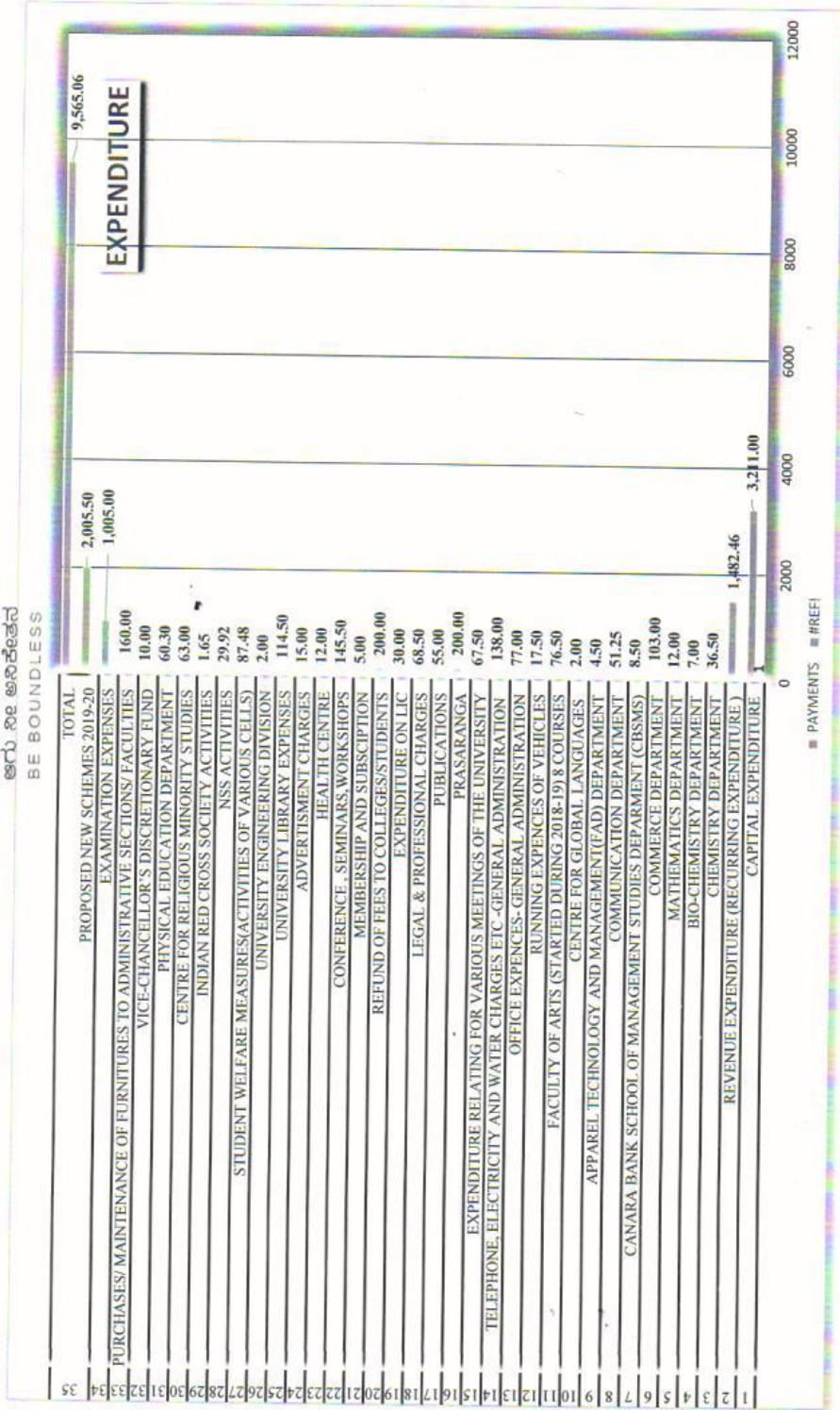

## **Guidelines for Admissions to Undergraduate Courses under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in the Faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce**

The Bengaluru Central University commences its academic year from 2019-20. The academic programmes will be governed by the Guidelines for adoption of Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) formulated by the University Grants Commission and the general guidelines issued by the State Higher Education Council, Govt. of Karnataka from time to time. The following Guidelines shall be observed by the affiliated colleges coming under the preview of the University while determining the eligibility for admission of students to courses. Further, the changes, if any, will be intimated as and when necessary.

A few salient points to determine eligibility for admission to various courses along with other important conditions are given below for ready reference.

### **1. ELIGIBILITY AND OTHER CONDITIONS:**

#### **1.1 B.A Degree Course (Bachelor of Arts)**

- a. A candidate who has passed the two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by the Karnataka Pre-University Board or any other examination considered as equivalent there to with any combination of optional subjects shall be eligible for admission to the B.A. degree course. The students admitted to B.A degree course shall opt for any three Arts subjects enumerated under the Faculty of Arts as optional subjects with equal weightage.
- b. The medium of instruction shall be either Kannada or English.

#### **1.2 B.Sc. Degree Course (Bachelor of Science)**

- a. A candidate who has passed two- year Pre-University Examination conducted by the Karnataka Pre-University Board consisting of at least two Science subjects (as enumerated under the Faculty of Science) or any other examination considered as equivalent there to shall be eligible for admission to B.Sc degree course. A candidate shall opt for any three Science subjects as optional subjects with equal weightage.
- b. Additional conditions of eligibility are required for specific subjects as follows:
  - i. A candidate opting for Physics should have studied Mathematics in addition to Physics at the qualifying examination.
  - ii. A candidate opting for Statistics should have studied that subject or Mathematics at the Pre-University level.
  - iii. A candidate opting for Biotechnology, Botany/Applied Botany, Microbiology or Zoology should have studied Biology at the Pre- University level.
  - iv. A candidate opting for Geology or Home Science should have studied at least two Science subjects at the Pre-University level.

#### **1.3 B.Com. Degree Course (Bachelor of Commerce)**

- a. A candidate who has passed the two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by the Karnataka Pre-University Board or any other examination considered as equivalent there to shall be eligible for admission to the B.Com programme.

- b. A candidate who has passed Diploma in Business Administration examination conducted by the Directorate of Technical Education, Karnataka may be considered eligible for admission to First Year B Com Degree course.
- c. A candidate who has passed Diploma in Secretarial / Commercial Practice conducted by the Board of Technical Education, Karnataka may be considered eligible for admission directly to Second Year (III Semester) B. Com. Degree course.
- d. The medium of instruction and examination shall be either English or Kannada.

#### **1.4 B.B.A Degree Course (Bachelor of Business Administration)**

- a. A candidate who has passed two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by the Karnataka Pre-University Board or any other examination considered as equivalent thereto shall be eligible for admission to the B.B.A course.
- b. The medium of instruction and examination shall be English.

#### **1.5 B.H.M Degree Course (Bachelor of Hotel Management)**

- a. A candidate who has passed the two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by the Karnataka Pre-University Board or any other examination considered as equivalent there to shall be eligible for admission
- b. Duration of the course:  
The course of study for the B.H. M degree shall extend over a period of four academic years, each academic year comprising of two semesters, each semester comprising sixteen weeks of class work. The candidates should complete the B.H.M degree within eight years from the date of admission to the First semester of the course.

#### **1.6 B. V. A Degree Course (Bachelor of Visual Arts)**

- a. A candidate to be eligible for admission to the First Semester Course of the Degree (Foundation) of Bachelor of Visual Arts in Painting/Applied Art/Sculpture/Print Making/Art History must fulfill the following requirements :
  - i. Must have passed the SSLC Examination conducted by the Secondary School Examination Board, Karnataka or an examination of any other State or body recognized as equivalent to the Secondary School Leaving Certificate Examination.
  - ii. Should pass an entrance aptitude test conducted by the concerned college.
- b. A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Fifth Semester of the Degree of Bachelor of Visual Arts must have passed all the four previous semesters.
- c. Duration of the course is 10 semesters. Candidates studying for the degree of Bachelor of Visual Arts in Painting/ Applied Art/ Sculpture/ Print Making/ Art History specialization are required to undergo training in prescribed study extending over total 10 semesters, and have

to pass the University examination at the end of third to tenth semesters. Languages are compulsory as per University regulations from Semester I to Semester IV.

### **1.7 B.Sc. Fashion and Apparel Design Degree Course (FAD)**

- a. A candidate who has passed the two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by the Karnataka Pre-University Board, or any other examination considered as equivalent there to shall be eligible for admission.
- b. A candidate with Diploma in Fashion Technology and Diploma in Costumes and Fashion Design conducted by the Department of Technical Education, Government of Karnataka is eligible for admission directly to the III Semester of the course.
- c. A candidate who has passed Diploma in Handloom Technology and Diploma in Handloom and Textiles conducted by the Ministry of Textiles, Government of India is also eligible for admission directly to the III Semester of the course.
- d. The medium of instruction and examination shall be English.

### **1.8 BSLPA Degree Course (Bachelor in Speech and Language Pathology and Audiology)**

- a. A candidate who has passed the two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by the Karnataka Pre-University Board or any other examination considered as equivalent thereto shall be eligible for admission if they fulfill the following conditions:

The candidate should have obtained 50% or more marks in any one of the following combination of subjects (45% in case of SC/ ST group)

- i. Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics
  - ii. Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology.
  - iii. Physics, Mathematics, Computer Science.
  - iv. Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology
- b. The candidate should have attained 17 years of age on July 1 of the year of admission and not have attained the age of 22 years to be eligible for admission. Upper age limit is relaxable by two years for candidates belonging to SC/ ST categories.
  - c. Lateral entry to Second Year BSLPA is permitted for candidates who meet the following criteria:
    - i. Successfully passed Diploma in Hearing-Language-Speech revised course from any RCI recognized training institute with Science background as specified.
    - ii. Two years of work experience in the field. A maximum of three seats can be admitted on merit basis as supernumerary to total intake permitted by RCI and the university. For candidates who have successfully passed the pre-revised DHLS course recognized by RCI with two years of work experience, three months Stint Course approved by RCI's Entrance Test will be the requirement.
  - d. Duration of the Course: Course shall be 6+2 semesters with course work in the 6<sup>th</sup> Semester and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester internship. Each semester will be of a minimum period of 18 weeks excluding examination duration.

### **1.9 B.C.A. Degree Course (Bachelor of Computer Application)**

- a. A candidate who has passed the two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by the Karnataka Pre-University Board or any other examination considered as equivalent thereto shall be eligible for admission.
- b. A candidate who has passed JODC /Three-year Diploma in Engineering of Government of Karnataka or any other examination considered as equivalent thereto shall be eligible for admission to First Year degree course.

#### **Duration of the courses:**

Unless otherwise mentioned, the duration of each course is a period of three years (six semesters), each academic year comprising of two semesters, each semester comprising sixteen weeks of class work, excluding the duration of examinations. The course should be completed within six years from the year of joining, failing which the candidate has to join the course afresh.

### **2. Guidelines regarding choice of languages for study in undergraduate programmes:**

- a. Two languages are to be studied out of which one shall be English and the other shall be either any Indian Language or a Foreign language other than English. -Kannada, Sanskrit, Hindi, Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam, Marathi, Konkani, Urdu, Persian, Arabic, German, French, Latin, Russian, Japanese and any other language prescribed/approved by the university.
- b. In addition to English, a candidate shall opt for any one of the two languages studied at the Pre-University or equivalent level. However, the candidate may opt for Kannada even if it is not studied at the Pre-University or equivalent level. With the permission of the University, a candidate may opt for any other language listed above even if the candidate has not studied that language at PUC or equivalent level.
- c. The following categories of candidates are permitted to opt for Additional English in lieu of Indian Languages:
  - i. Candidates who have passed 10 +2 Examination from CBSE/ ISCE and who have not studied any Indian Languages at the qualifying examination.
  - ii. Candidates who have passed the qualifying Examination from North Eastern States like West Bengal, Assam, Meghalaya, Nagaland etc and who have studied subjects like Bengali, Assamese etc; at their qualifying examination.
  - iii. Candidates who have studied French in the qualifying examination.
  - iv. Candidates who want to change the Language to Additional English giving the valid reason that the colleges are not offering the languages which they have studied at the qualifying examination.
- d. Speech/hearing/visually impaired/mentally challenged and study disabled students are exempted from studying one of the languages prescribed under para 3 of the above.
- e. In case of Foreign Nationals who have not studied an Indian Language, the Vice Chancellor shall have the power to permit them to study any two languages or English or Additional English.

### **3. Guidelines for Issue of Eligibility Certificate:**

- a. Colleges desirous of admitting the candidates to various degree courses who have passed their qualifying examination i.e. Pre- University course conducted by the Karnataka Pre-University Board do not require an Eligibility Certificate from the University and may be admitted if they fulfill the requirements of the Bengaluru Central University regulations governing that particular course.
- b. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination conducted by the recognized Boards/ Universities outside the State of Karnataka and within the country seeking admissions to various courses may be admitted without Eligibility Certificate, provided they satisfy the requirements of the Bengaluru Central University Regulations governing that particular course. However, these candidates have to pay Rs 1,100/ towards the Eligibility Fee.
- c. Indian National students who have passed the qualifying examinations of 10+2 conducted by the examining bodies of India like CBSE, ICSE, and Government of Kerala etc; outside India need not apply for issue of Eligibility Certificates. However, they have to pay Rs 2,200/ towards Eligibility Fee. Indian national students who have passed the qualifying examination conducted by the Examining Bodies of other countries should obtain Eligibility Certificate from the University before seeking admission.
- d. In case of any doubt, admissions shall be made only after confirmation of the eligibility from the university.

### **4. Requirement for Issue of Eligibility Certificate in respect of Foreign National Students:**

Foreign Nationals seeking admissions to various courses are advised to apply for Eligibility Certificate in the prescribed application form, which the college may obtain from the University, Central College campus, Bengaluru 560001 on payment of Rs. 100/ perform. The completed application form along with necessary documents duly attested by the Principal may be forwarded to the University after due scrutiny, provided the candidate satisfies all the requirements of the Bengaluru Central University Regulation relating to admission to a particular course. The candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations recognized by the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi as equivalent to 10+2 stage of examination in India only are required to apply for issue of Eligibility Certificates. Applications of only eligible candidates may be forwarded duly signing the Certificates in the application forms specifically provided. Foreign Nationals should not be admitted without Eligibility Certificate issued by the University on any account. Applications received without supporting documents and also after the last date will be rejected.

### **Documents required for Eligibility Certificate:**

The following documents shall be submitted along with applications in the prescribed form for issue of Eligibility Certificate in case of Foreign Nationals / Indian Nationals who have passed the qualifying examination of other countries for admission to courses under all the Faculties in Bengaluru Central University:

- i. Attested copies of Marks cards/ Pass certificates
- ii. Attested copies of valid passport and Student Visa
- iii. One passport size photograph to be pasted on the application.

- iv. Two stamp size photographs.
- v. AIDS Test Clearance Certificate.
- vi. Original fee receipt for payment of Eligibility Fee.

Further, the following may be noted while determining the eligibility of the Foreign National:

- i. Candidates who have studied the required cognate subjects in 9<sup>th</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> Grade, not in the 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> Grade of High School, Graduation, diploma of USA and other examinations are not eligible.
- ii. Candidates who have not studied the concerned cognate subjects in 'A' level GCE Examination are also not eligible for admission to First-Year degree course under all Faculties.

**5. Guidelines for transfer of students from other Universities / Colleges in the middle of the course:**

- a. Principals are permitted to make admissions on transfer fee following the regulations and collecting the fees of Rs 100/- per candidate and send the admission statement of such students in triplicate along with the records / recommendations for consideration and approval by the University. However, the candidates seeking admission on transfer with change of one subject within the university shall obtain No Objection Certificate from the University prior to their admission in the new college by paying prescribed fees of Rs 100/- + Rs. 150/- Total Rs. 250/-.
- b. In case of students seeking transfer from one University to another within Karnataka and students of other Universities within India, the Principals are permitted to issue No Objection Certificate indicating the vacancy, willingness for admission of such candidates and forward to the University for issue of permission and eligibility. No inter University transfer should be made directly by the Principals without obtaining No Objection Certificate from the University.
- c. Admission statement in respect of transfer students along with documents like marks cards, transfer certificate, No Objection Certificate and fee paid receipt towards transfer fees has to be forwarded to the University for approval of their admissions.
- d. Candidates who are admitted to the Evening Degree Course shall not be eligible for admission to Regular/ Day degree course in the middle of the course.

**6. Guidelines regarding Attendance:**

In respect of all the above courses:

- a. Each Semester shall be taken into consideration for purpose of calculating attendance.
- b. Students shall attend Lectures/ Practical Classes / seminars as prescribed and not absent themselves from college without adequate reason.
- c. In respect of all the above courses, except BSLPA course, a student shall be considered to have completed a semester if he/she has attended not less than 75% of the total number of classes conducted and if his/her conduct has been satisfactory.



- d. In respect of BSLPA course, each candidate should maintain at least 80% attendance in theory classes and 90% attendance in Clinical Practice in each semester.
- e. Failure to meet the required attendance will disqualify a student from appearing in the University Semester Examination. He/ she will be eligible to appear subsequently only after meeting the requirements of minimum attendance. All colleges are required to display shortage of attendance every month on the college notice board and also upload the same on the website. A copy is to be sent to the Registrar (Evaluation).

**7. General Guidelines:**

- a. The University will issue Calendar of Events in all the courses at the beginning of the academic year. Principals, including those of Autonomous Colleges, are required to cooperate with the University and strictly adhere to the Calendar of Events.
- b. The affiliated colleges, including Autonomous Colleges, are required to display the Admission Calendar prominently on the college notice board and college website.
- c. Merit lists should be prepared, keeping in mind government and university regulations regarding reserved seats and must also be prominently displayed on college notice board and website.
- d. Admissions shall be made only to courses and combinations sanctioned by the university.
- e. Approval will not be given to combinations and courses wherein the number admitted are less than the minimum number fixed by the Government/ University order.
- f. Admission to various courses should be made strictly as per the intake sanctioned by the Government/ University. No college shall make any excess admission over and above the intake. A student whose admission has become invalid or whose admission has not been approved by the University or who has been admitted to a college in excess of the prescribed intake will not be eligible to appear for the examination conducted by either the college or the University under Section 61 of the KSU Act, 2000.
- g. If any admission intake is sanctioned by the Government it should be brought to the notice of the university before taking any action.
- h. Admission to courses shall not be made beyond the last date.
- i. Admissions to various courses in the degree colleges have to be made as per the UGC/ State Government / University rules in respect of reservation of seats for categories like SC/ ST and other Backward Community candidates. Principals are hereby directed to maintain 15% reservation of seats for SC, 3% for ST and such other backward classes as per the Government orders issued from time to time. Not less than 3% of seats shall be reserved for persons with disability in Government and Government-Aided Colleges. The above instructions/norms should be strictly adhered to in making admissions to all the degree courses.

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- k. Job Oriented Diploma Courses conducted by the Directorate of Vocational Education in Karnataka and other States are considered equivalent to two year PUC of Karnataka, and such students are eligible for admission to I Year degree courses like BA/ BSc/BBA/ BHM/ BSc (FAD)/ BCA courses in the affiliated colleges of Bengaluru Central University as per the notifications issued in this regard.
- l. Students who have passed job-linked Post SSLC Training Examination and Vocational Course conducted by Government of Karnataka State Council of Vocational Education are not eligible for admission to any degree course in Bengaluru Central University.
- m. Candidates who have passed in AISSCE conducted by CBSE, Delhi but failed in any one of the cognate subjects of the qualifying examinations are not eligible for admission to I Year B. Sc degree with combination of the cognate subject in which they have failed.
- n. Candidates belonging to Backward Tribe of outside Karnataka State (other than SC/ ST) are not eligible to claim relaxation in the percentage minimum in their qualifying examination.
- o. The candidates who have passed the following examinations may also be considered eligible for admission to First Year degree course under all faculties subject to fulfillment of other conditions stipulated in the Regulations of each course:
  - i. Senior Secondary School Certificate examination conducted by National Open School, New Delhi as +2 stage examination corresponding to the Pre- University examination.
  - ii. "Instant" Intermediate examination conducted by the Andhra Pradesh Intermediate Examination Board.
- p. Candidates who are deaf and dumb or have learning disability and who have to study an Indian Language compulsorily at degree courses as per the existing regulations are hereby exempted from studying that Indian Language.

**8. Guidelines for Admission Approval Process:**

**I. Online admission approval process**

- i. Online submission of details to be uploaded on university portal on scheduled dates announced by the University.
- ii. Download of Admission Approval statement displayed on University portal before last date of online submission.

**II. Physical Verification**

Following documents are to be submitted at the time of approval:

- i. Admission statement.
- ii. University Order showing sanctioned intake.
- iii. Original Xth and XIIth standard and equivalent examinations marks cards.
- iv. Original Transfer Certificate.
- v. Migration Certificate from students other than from Karnataka PU Board.
- vi. Eligibility Certificate for Foreign Nationals and NRIs.
- vii. Certificate issued by relevant authority in case of reservation/quota claims.
- viii. Copy of Bank Payment Receipt

**9. Mode of remittance of various fees:**

Colleges have to collect and remit for each student admission approval fee i.e, Admission, Registration, Sports, Development, Eligibility fees, late admission fees etc admitted to various course (other than BCA course) as per the fees prescribed in University Notification to the Bengaluru Central University Fund. In respect of BCA course, colleges have to collect and remit Admission, Registration, Sports, Development, and Eligibility fees etc, as per the rates prescribed in University Annexure A,B,C.
